Procession of Good Friday

The Passionate Biblical Procession of the History of Salvation is presided by the White Brotherhood. It begins at Capilla del Rosario, forming up along Lope Gisbert, Príncipe Alfonso and Santa Paula streets to enter the avenue around 8:00 p.m. Juan Carlos I (the only section where it can be seen in its entirety from the chairs) arriving at the Presidency at 8:30 p.m.

The Procession of Good Friday of Lorca is conceived as a huge auto sacramental as a living and monumental historical and testamentary frieze. The historical-biblical groups represent the main facts of the Old Testament, Sacred History and the penitential processions that correspond commemoration of the Day on which Christ died on the Cross. The presence of the revered titular images of the Blue and White Brotherhoods stands out, in their invocations of Dolorosa and Amargura, whose banners, cloaks and canopies constitute the first textile ensembles in Spain declared "Asset of Cultural Interest".


